News & Director/Committee Updates:

Restrictions Exemption Program in effect at all BHCL facilities:

As we transition to more in-person activities, the health, safety and wellness of our community league members and partners is a top priority for the Beverly Heights Community League Board when considering and planning community events.

As a Board, we have made the decision to implement the Restrictions Exemption Program (REP) at our facilities – the Beverly Heights Community League Hall, Family Centre and Sports Building/Rink. In addition, a vaccination policy for staff and volunteers has been approved to ensure our patrons and renters feel comfortable while enjoying our venue. All those visiting, volunteering, or working in the Beverly Heights Community League Hall, Family Centre and Sports Building who are age 12+ must be able to show proof of vaccination, or a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours, or original medical exemption documentation. Masks continue to be required. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation!

Beverly Rink Update

The Ice Maker/Rink Attendant has been hired and flooding has started. The rink will likely be open by mid-December (weather permitting), skating times will be announced in the next few weeks and will be on the website beverlyheights.ca/skating/ and on the Beverly Heights Community League Facebook Group.

Thank you to Sports Central and the Tegler Centre/Hope Mission for skate donations - we have nearly all sizes available to borrow. We do not have many helmets, however, and helmets are required for all those under age 18 so please send your child with a helmet.

To access the building/washrooms proof of COVID-19 vaccination (QR code) will be required for those 12+ as well as ID for those 18+. Negative test within 72 hours or original documentation of medical exemption is also accepted.

Skating at outdoor rinks is free with your community league membership and skate tags, or is \$2 per person. You can purchase your Beverly Heights Community League membership at the rink during skating hours.




