

4. MEMBERSHIP


- a) Membership shall be granted to any resident within the stated boundaries upon payment of a membership fee as proscribed by the Board of Directors.
- b) Any member wishing to withdraw from membership may do so upon notice, in writing, to the Board through its Secretary. If a member has not paid the annual membership fee, or has moved outside the defined boundaries, the member is considered to have submitted their resignation. Honourary life members are exempt from fees and boundary restrictions.
- d) Any member, in good standing, shall be entitled to vote, take part in debates or address the meeting at the Annual General Meeting. Members may attend all Directors meetings but are not eligible to vote nor may they participate in debates or address the meeting without the permission of the President.

5. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- a) Prospective new members of the Board of Directors must be members in good standing of the Beverly Heights Community League.
 - c) Directors will be elected for two year terms and may serve no more than three consecutive terms.

Recognizing and Avoiding Investment Scams Fraud Types:

- Affinity fraud starts close to home at social clubs, ethnic communities etc
- Ponzi schemes promises high rates of return with little or no risk to investors.
- Pump & Dump offers incredible deals on low priced stock, the stock skyrockets as people invest, the promoter dumps his shares at peak and the stock plummets becoming worthless.

Common types of Investment Fraud

- bit coins binary options
- foreign exchange trading
- crypto related- check the registration of the platform. Avoid unsolicited opportunities through social media, ads and online groups, dating apps that are promoting high returns. *checkfirst.ca

Red Flags of Fraud

- guaranteed high rate of return, no risk great opportunity,
- friends can't be wrong profit like the experts
- don't miss limited opportunity get in now offshore investment, tax free
- celebrity endorsement, must be legitimate

- How to protect yourself: CHECK PROTECT INVEST
- start at checkfirst.ca, do they have a disciplinary history?
- do your homework does it sound too good to be true?
