# BEVERLY HEIGHTS COMMUNITY LEAGUE FEATURES

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## Playgrounds and outdoor spaces:

With beautiful river valley views, wide streets with mature trees, and many green spaces to enjoy, Beverly Heights and Rundle Heights are perfect for outdoor enthusiasts.

### In the community:

- **Floden Park:** 4209 111 Ave
- **Penny Park:** 4201 115 Ave
- **Laneway Park:** 3807 108 Ave (in the alley just west of 38 St, north of 106 Ave)
- **Rundle Heights Playground:** 34 St & 109 Ave (newly updated!)
- **North Beverly Playground:** 11615 36 St (just west of No Frills)
- **School Playground:** 116 Ave & 39 St (former RJ Scott school)
- **John J. Olinyk Park:** 115 Ave and 46 St, walking trails, fitness equipment and green space to enjoy
- **Beverly Sports Field:** 111 Ave from 40-42 St
- **Beverly Heights Community Rink and Sports Building:** 10906 40 St with one rink with boards and one smaller “snowbank” rink open seasonally. Free loaner skates available. Skating on outdoor community rinks is free with your community league membership!

### In the nearby area:

- **Rundle Park / ACT Centre:** large playground, walking/biking trails, ponds with geese, paddle boat rentals, disc golf, tennis courts, ball diamonds, sledding hills, Rundle Park Golf Course, outdoor skating/iceway, ACT recreation centre & pool.
- **Jubilee Playground and Spray Park:** 121 Ave & 43 St
- **Montrose Spray Park:** 59 St & 119 Ave
- **Highlands Spray Park:** 62 St & 112 Ave

### Biking and walking trails:

- Rundle Park / ACT. Cross the river on the Ainsworth Dyer Memorial Bridge and explore Gold Bar Park, or head northeast and visit the Strathcona Science Park and bridge. Access the path down the hill to Rundle Park from 104 Ave just east of 36 Street.
- Ada Blvd: head west behind the community hall, west of 50<sup>th</sup> Street into Highlands. The Magrath Mansion is on 63 St and Ada Blvd. Or cross the river on the Capilano Foot Bridge (head south just after 52 St and Ada Blvd).
- Take a stroll, walk your dog, wave to the neighbours, and enjoy the wide streets with mature trees throughout our neighbourhood - take a walk or bike ride and explore the yards in bloom and seasonal décor.

## Active Community League:

The Beverly Heights Community League volunteer board members, with the help of community members, plan and coordinate events, activities and programs.
